



WCCF Gives charities that secure 100% board participation through the day of giving will be entered for a chance to win a **\$5,000 grant from the Acorn Fund!**

The grant recipient will be announced in the Fourth Quarter.

- Provide your Board members' names and contact information to the *WCCF* via the Get Your Board on Board! registration form.
- The link to the form will be available after registration for *WCCF Gives* has closed.
- Your Board schedule must be submitted by August 31 in order to participate in this opportunity.
- In order to be considered towards the participation percentage, a Board member's name must be included in the payment method and/or the acknowledgement line of that person's *Gives* gift.
- Anonymous giving is possible for Board members who wish to do so, but the Board member's name must be included in the payment method.
- All gifts must be *WCCF Gives*-eligible (made by check, credit card, or IRA; \$25 or more; postmarked by September 14).
- Since board sizes vary greatly, the Foundation will be tracking the board participation percentage instead of number of board members who give. (But remember, each board member also will count towards the pro-rated \$50,000 donor bonus pool distribution.)
- After *Gives* day, the *WCCF* will cross your provided Board schedule against your list of *Gives* donors.
- Only *WCCF Gives* charities with 100% board participation will be entered for a chance to win a \$5,000 *Acorn Fund* grant.

FAQ

Q: Why must charities register to participate in Get Your Board on Board?

A: There is no way for us to know who is a member of every participating charity's board.

Q: Why do we need to provide you with our board member's contact information?

A: To ensure that we are correctly pairing donors with their gifts, we need a point of reference that is current and accurate.
